**Educational Visit to the Imperial War Museum and Houses of Parliament**

We are proposing an educational visit for children in year 6 to London on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December.

The plan for the day is as follows:-

Planned time of departure from school 7.30am (travelling by coach)

Arrive at the Imperial War Museum at approximately 9.30am – we have been given use of the dining room and will have lunch before we go to the Houses of Parliament.

Tour of Houses of Parliament with activity session on democracy and citizenship.

Planned time of return to School 6.00pm (subject to traffic).

To help us cover the cost of the visit, we would be grateful for a contribution of £15. If this presents a difficulty for you, please contact Mr McDonagh, in complete confidence, because we will want to do everything possible to make sure all the children can take part.

Your child will need to bring a packed lunch, including a still drink in a plastic container. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please let us know if you would like the school kitchen to prepare a packed lunch by completing the attached slip. Due to the length of the day, your child may wish to bring an extra snack of fruit or cereal bar.

Children are expected to wear school uniform and school shoes and a waterproof coat. If your child needs to take travel sickness pills, please contact your child's teacher.

Children will not need to bring any money.

We thought it may help to divide the payments up so are asking for the following:-

£10 Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November

£5 Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> December

Of course you can also pay the full amount up front if you wish. I would be grateful if you could complete the attached slip and return it to me with the first payment on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> November, in a sealed envelope marked with your child's name, class and 'Educational Visit to London'
